



MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: October 7, 2024

Operations:

- We responded to 65 calls in September.
- Brush 56 (Big Bird) was picked up and received funds per board approval last month.
- I am working on an updated apparatus plan and hope to present the draft in November.

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Stage 1 fire restrictions are in place.
- On October 2, Brush 52 headed back to Wyoming for a Forest Service support assignment. They are currently based in Laramie. The unit is staffed with two from the TFPD Mitigation Crew and One ENGB trainee from Clear Creek Fire.
- The new chassis for Brush 52 has a VIN number and is scheduled to hit the assembly line at Ford on Monday. There is no ETA on its delivery to Olathe, KS.
- I am submitting a FRWRM grant this week for 3 full-time Mitigation Employees. This is a 50% match. TFPD would match two, and Nederland Fire would match one.
- The mitigation schedule is booked through the end of the year. We are now scheduling into January 2025.

Administration:

- Hoping to hear soon about the DOLA EIAF grant.
- The draft budget is complete and in your hands. Budget workshop proposed date December 3rd, 12-4:00?
- Thank you to the Timberline Volunteer Firefighters Foundation, which purchased TV's for the Station 3 dayroom and future gym, as well as new barbeques for Stations 3 and 5.
- High Country Auxiliary approved \$9000 to replace our Knox Box keys secured in the trucks, \$7500 for additional gym equipment, and \$2000 for catering of our annual holiday event.

R&R:

- 14 new volunteers completed the five-day onboarding on Saturday and will be ready to begin shifting.
- Thank you to High Country Auxiliary, who provided 3 meals for the onboarding classes.

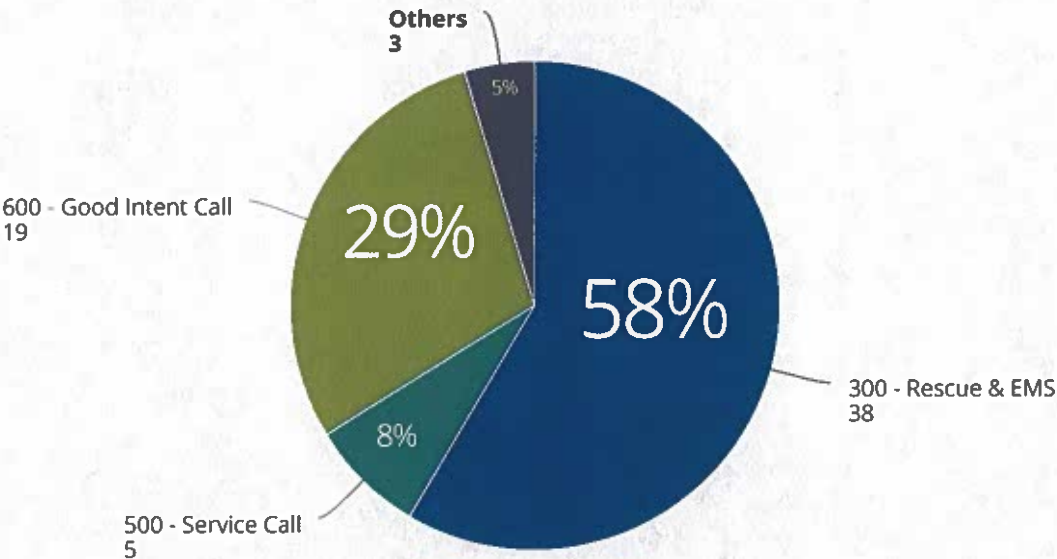

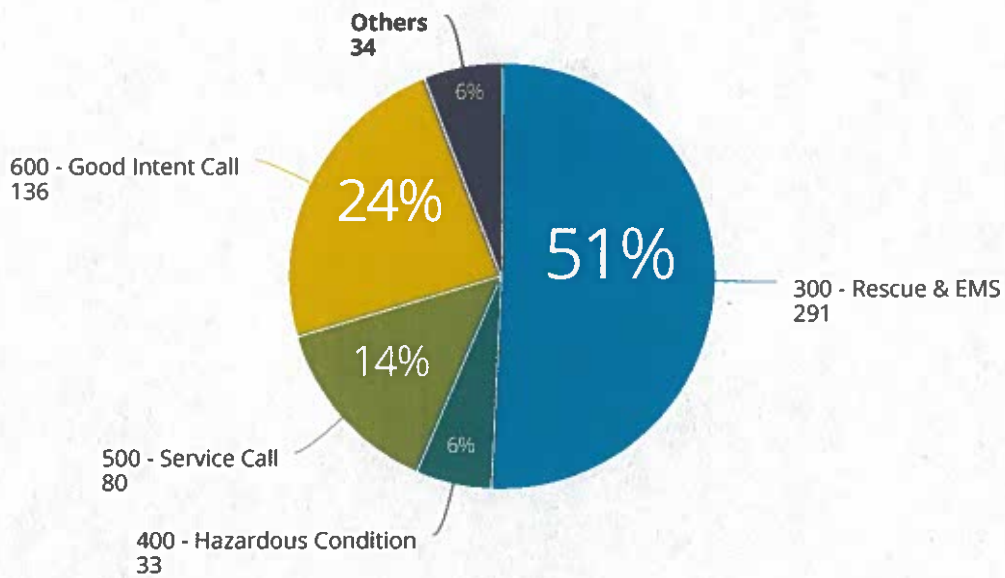
