



MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: November 9, 2021

Operations:

- We responded to 60 calls in October.
- We have created a new volunteer Captain position in our organization chart. There will be a North one over station 1-4 and a South one over 6-9. The North will be filled at the all hands meeting with Clay Bosworth and the South is going to be vacant for now.
- Will be bringing on 4-6 new volunteers in early December.
- Live fire training in Boulder last Saturday we had 22 people in attendance including TFPD, Central City Fire and Golden Gate Fire.
- Gilpin OEM, TFPD are hosting ICS 300 this weekend, being taught by FEMA.

Wildland:

- Brush 56 returned late Sunday, they were assigned to the Windy Fire in California for 7 weeks.
- Chief Hinderman is working feverishly on billing.

Administration:

- Our Alan Green Grant request was denied – letter attached to packet.
- I submitted a small grant request to RETAC (Regional Emergency Trauma Advisory Council) for some EMS equipment.
- We are considering an AFG (Assistance to Firefighters Grant) station modification grant for fire sprinklers and or fire alarm for Station 7.
- We are considering applying for a Fire Prevention grant in February. This will target wildfire risk reduction.
- Applying for Fire Fighter Safety and Disease Grant through the Division of Fire requesting 6 sets of structure coat and pants.
