



MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: October 14, 2021

Operations:

- We responded to 60 calls in September
- September 19th: Pactolus fire
- September 24th: Mutual Aid structure fire in Coal Creek
- September 25th: responded to a small intentionally set wildland fire in Kelly Dahl Campground
- Tender 57 was finally repaired. Rosenbauer and SVI engineers were able to trouble shoot the issue over the phone.

Wildland:

- After Brush 56 returned from Black Mountain is was relisted and sent to the Windy Fire in California. The first crew worked 16 days (20 with travel) then we did a crew swap. It is scheduled to be there till the 22nd or 23rd. We have a crew ready to swap again if needed.
- No current fire bans within our district

Administration:

- Three new in-district fire fighters.
- Applied for Alan Green Grant requesting \$3,848 for 4 sets of dual-compliant wildand/extrication gear
- Will be applying for Fire Fighter Safety and Disease Grant requesting 6 sets of traditional firefighter structure coat and pants.
- We received \$5,550 from HCA to purchase traffic safety vests, job-shirts and polos. The auxiliary is going to re-reviewing our request in November for the additional requested items.
- We have requested \$25,000 from Gilpin County for mitigation efforts for 2022.
- Weekly COVID-19 rapid-testing is occurring for all employees (first work shift each week).
- All hands meeting November 19th, the board will be serving all firefighters
